

# Catalogue on available online modules

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### 1 Publishable Summary

The aim of this document is to present the catalogue of online courses for cluster manager, which have been identified as interesting for the EXCITE project partners and other European clusters.

This task is responding to the following objectives:

- Develop the necessary skills for excellence in cluster management, in particular with regard to scale-up activities and digital services.
- Uptake transversal facilitating skills for promoting high quality services to their members.
- Identify and transfer good management practices both in their daily activities and new potential services to promote business acceleration and scaling up.

That is why we have published this online catalogue, accessible through this link - it consists in an open, online document for any cluster interested to have their staff trained to cluster management and transversal skills. This document will be updated within the project lifecycle and beyond by GAIA with the inputs received from the EXCITE project partners.

Different communication channels will be used to share this catalogue in different networks, such as websites, newsletters, social media or ECCP platform.

A first version of the catalogue was shared by GAIA and the project partners provided inputs to update and complete the catalogue.



### 2 Introduction to the project

EXCITE aims to strengthen cluster management and facilitate exchange and strategic partnership between cluster staff and cluster members by using the ClusterXchange mobility scheme. ClusterXchange is a new pilot project to promote short-term exchanges to better connect industrial ecosystems in Europe. The project will focus on skills, processes and services related to digital transformation - both in terms of the cluster organisation itself and its members, to be able to support them in successfully accessing global markets.

One of the objectives of the project is to improve skills of staff of all the participating clusters to improve cluster management weaknesses and the digital skills of the people involved in the EXCITE project member clusters. That's why the selection of trainings available in the Catalogue was based on the identified challenges faced by the EXCITE cluster partners, which were described in the internal strategy analysis carried out by SCS cluster. Nevertheless, the Catalogue is publicly accessible and can be used by any European clusters in need for skills improvement of their teams.

Practically, this Catalogue consists in a database gathering the most interesting online resources accessible for clusters where any cluster might select relevant trainings for their staff and management teams.

All partners of EXCITE have been responsible for contributing by adding all the relevant courses and GAIA has been responsible to compile everything and put it together.

The present report gives an overview of the courses that are interesting for the EXCITE cluster partner management teams.

### 3 Collection process

### 3.1 Pre-analysis

This report is coming from the results of the previous project task 2.1 which goal was to analyse internal strategies to define the clusters baseline. This analysis served as basis to know which are the main aspect that project partner clusters need to address in relation to new skills development.

Using this information published in the internal Deliverable D2.1 "Skills development plan" (Confidential), research has been done to find and select courses that were addressing the identified needs. In this case, all project partners were responsible to provide information and links to known courses for this purpose. Then GAIA as leader of this specific task has been responsible to add all the information in a shared file and publish it.

To be aligned with the previous works within the Work Package 2, main areas of the cluster management have been used to identify the relevant courses:

- Cluster Structure
- Cluster Strategy
- Cluster Organisation/Operations
- Business Models
- Communication

After a first version was sent to all partners with the courses found at that time, the partners had one month to provide any additional course that they could find, and the resulting table (below) is the final version of the courses identified.

### 3.2 Sources

The online courses indicated in the table are stemming from different sources checked and researched by the project partners. These are of very different kinds, from universities offering courses, to various European projects developing trainings. The EXCITE project partners are very active in different European projects and count on different kind of networks.

The sources used for the selection of training online courses have been:

- <u>European projects:</u> all partners are involved in different European projects and in some of them some trainings have been developed and have been listed. For instance, SCS the coordinator of the Cluster4Smart project.
- Other European partners: in some occasions, some other partners from European projects or networks have developed trainings even if no partners from EXCITE were involved and have been indicated too.
- European Cluster Conference Platform: some interesting courses and materials can also be
  found on the ECCP platform. All project partners are active on this platform and receive the
  newsletters. Some courses such as the Cluster Booster Academy have also been organised
  thanks to their initiative.
- <u>Universities and trainings centres:</u> some universities have online courses relevant and interesting for cluster managers.
- Other online course providers: platforms like Coursera or Google also have some interesting materials available for anybody. It is rather related to digital transformation and more about transversal skills acquisition.

Even if above are listed the main used and checked sources, other online trainings are or will be available, and the Catalogue might be further updated with new relevant references.



### 4 List of online courses

By now the list of the online courses can be found in the link below, and will be operational and updated during the project and after.

By now, the main online courses published in the catalogue are distinguished in two kinds of courses:

- the courses directly addressing the cluster manager
- the courses addressing transversal skills, still very important in terms of digitalisation or project management, among others.

In each of the courses, there are some items identified, such as course name, keywords, length, and cost. There are many more courses that could be added to this file, but a selection has been carried out to avoid many duplicities.

Some of the courses selected are temporary, which means that they might have deadlines for registration - but in most cases, the sources indicated are permanent and can be taken whenever the user prefers or has availability.

The online Catalogue has been built upon the information about specific needs of each cluster from the preliminary analysis conducted during Task 2.1, and we have defined a specific capacity building program for the EXCITE partners. On such basis, relevant available online courses have been identified and added to the online Catalogue, freely accessible by all. The consortium consciously disagreed with subcontracting here, as numerous quality materials are already available from previous projects developed by the project partners and other partnerships. As a result, EXCITE has published an online Catalogue which is alive with learning opportunities which will be used for skill development of the individual cluster staff.

As mentioned, in the frame of the EXCITE project, the consortium cluster partners have expressed their interest in courses in the Catalogue that could be relevant for their staff, and after individual analysis within their teams, they have been selecting the matching courses according to their team members' specific teams.
